Time – Approx. 90 minutes

5. Making Connections – discuss and explore connections between topic and other topic areas and subjects.
6. Text – Use books, web pages, newspapers, magazines where appropriate.
7. Media – use video clips and programmes and/or computer programmes and websites where appropriate.
8. Individual Work Activity.
9. Record through text and illustrations. Pupils under 10 to copy teacher's whiteboard recording. Pupils above 10 to record using their own words.
10. Plenary & Quiz.
